- She was one of the Bronte sisters , between Charlotte and Anne . She published her works under the pseudonym Ellis Bell .

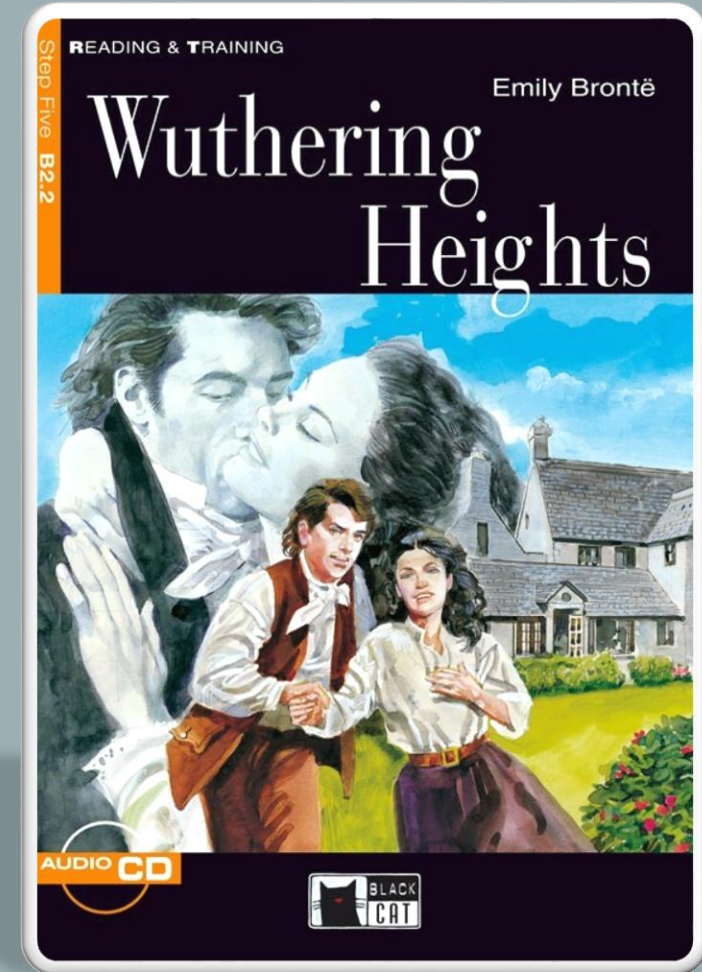

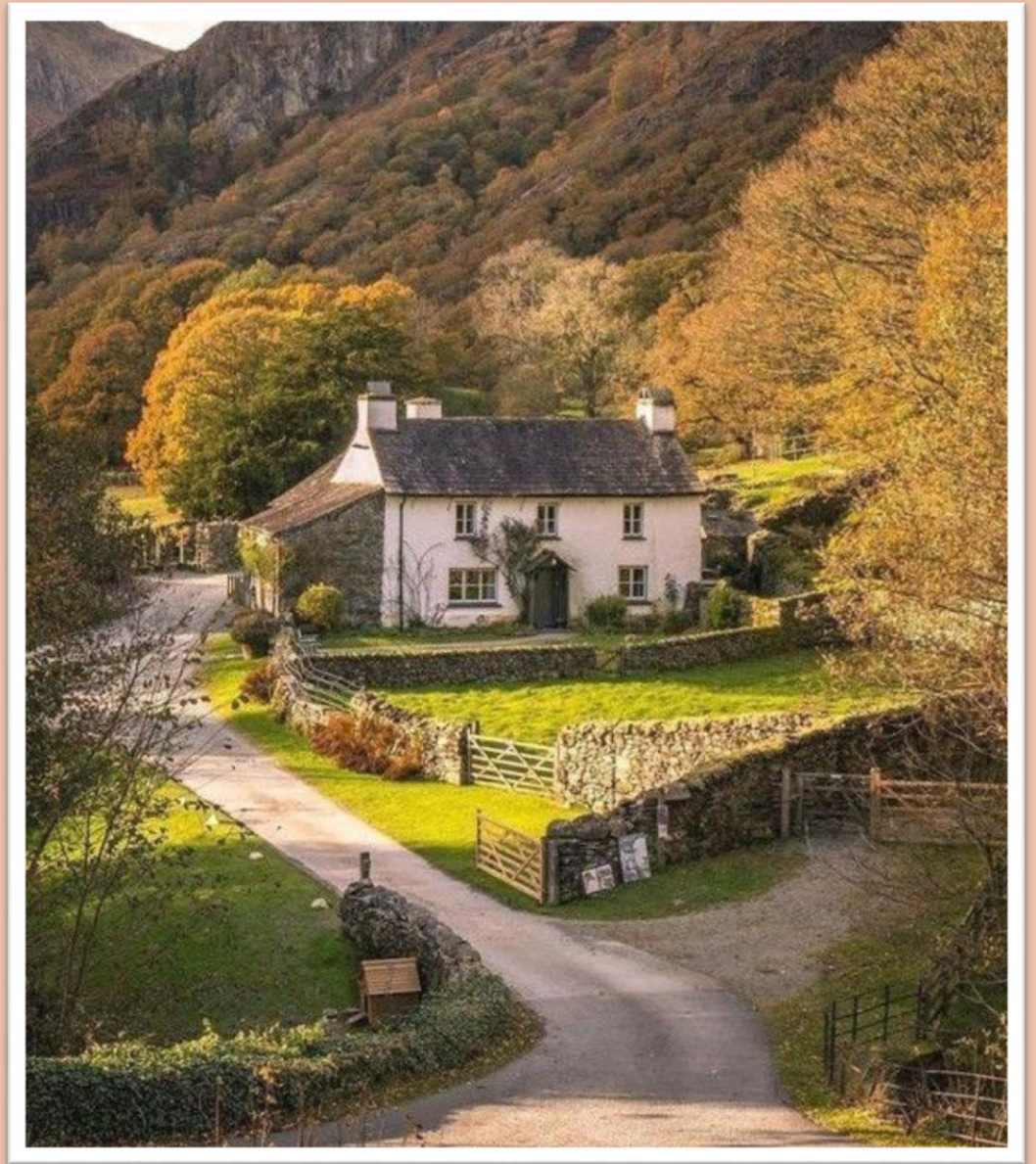
